



Rombout Hunt Hunter Pace Guidelines



- *** Social-distancing guidelines will be strictly enforced. ***
- All pace attendees must wear face masks unless on horseback!**
- *** Lunch to-go will be provided. We ask you to kindly grab and go.
- *** No Pace times or results will be posted the day of the event.
- *** Ribbons will all be mailed out to those who place in the top 10.

TEAMS: Competitors must ride in teams of two or three. Times will run until “last” rider completes the course.

TIME: The ideal pace time will be determined in the following manner. Two members of Rombout will ride the course at a pace similar to that of an actual hunt (this will be the ideal time). The team will then be excluded from the winning scores. The pace setting time will be kept secret until all riders have completed the course.

CHECK POINT: There will be at least one check point of 3 minutes. Teams missing a check point will be disqualified.

DRESS: Casual attire is standard. Hard hats and proper footwear required. Any other questions about attire should be referred to the pace secretary.

STARTING TIME: The Hunter Pace begins at 9:30 am. No Starting times will be assigned. Pace starts will be first come, first served. Please be sure to follow us on Facebook in the event of a cancellation.

START CUT-OFF TIME: 1:00 pm. The cut-off time may be extended only at the discretion of the Pace Organizers.

ENTRY FEE: Senior (18 and over): \$80/rider / Juniors (17 & under): \$60.00/rider.

Refunds will be made only if the Hunter Pace is canceled by the Pace Organizers.

DIVISIONS: Team members may be changed or added day of pace, which may result in the change of Division.

- **First Flight** (all teams regardless of age groups):—suitable for those who generally ride at quicker paces.
- **Juniors/Pony Club** (all riders must be 17 or under or be a current PC member): No adults allowed in this division. Optimal time same as first flight.
- **Hill Topper** (all teams regardless of age groups): A leisurely pace, for those who are in no hurry. Adults and juniors welcome.

RAIN DATE: In the event of inclement weather, please be sure to check Facebook or contact the Secretary via cell phone or email by 8am the day of for information on the go / no go decision . There will be no rain date. In the event of cancellation, refunds will be issued.

DIRECTIONS TO GONE AWAY FARM—18 Browning Road, Hyde Park, NY

Directions from Connecticut or Westchester

Van & trailers: Rt. 684 North to Brewster exit. Get on Rt. 22 North to Rt. 55 West. Stay on Rt. 55 & pass under Taconic Pkwy. Make a right turn onto Freedom Plains Rd. (Mobile gas station on corner). Stay on Freedom Plains Rd. until end, then make a left turn onto R. 44 West (about 2nd traffic light, CVS on right). Make a quick right turn onto West Rd. & stay on West Rd. until it ends. At stop sign, take a right and then a quick left onto Gretna Rd. (at animal hospital). Stay on Gretna Rd. until it ends (lake at end). Go left at stop sign onto Netherwood Rd. and follow around the bend. Make first right onto Marshall Rd. Go 2 miles & bear right; Marshall Rd. turns into Browning Rd. YOU ARE ALMOST THERE. Continue short distance on Browning Rd. to parking signs.

Directions from Rt. 9 (from South or North)

Vans, trailers & passenger cars: Take Rt. 9 to Rt. 9G south/north to the East Park traffic light (Mobil station on Southeast corner). Make left/right onto Crum Elbow Rd., which becomes Netherwood Rd. Go straight through traffic light and make left onto Marshall Rd. Go 2 miles and bear right; Marshall Rd. turns into Browning Rd. YOU ARE ALMOST THERE. Continue short distance on Browning Rd. to parking signs.
